**Hashir Aazh** PhD, is an audiologist in private practice who has treated thousands of patients with tinnitus, hyperacusis and misophonia using a specialised rehabilitation programme based on Cognitive Behaviour Therapy (CBT). He has trained and supervised over a thousand audiologists and psychologists, and published over 50 research papers in the field of audiology. He is Honorary Hearing Research Consultant at the Royal Surrey NHS Foundation Trust (UK), Affiliate Associate Professor at Florida Atlantic University (USA) and Visiting Research Fellow at the University of Surrey (UK). He has served as Managing Editor of the journal Noise and Health, Associate Editor of the International Journal of Audiology, and the Secretary of the British Society of Audiology. He is the organiser of the International Hyperacusis and Misophonia Conference.

**Richard S. Tyler** PhD, worked at the Institute of Hearing Research in the United Kingdom and is currently a Professor in both the Department of Otolaryngology - Head & Neck Surgery and in the Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders. In his line of work, he visited China, South Africa, Australia, Sweden, Poland, Germany and France. Tyler's main areas of interest include tinnitus, hyperacusis and cochlear implants. He edited the book Cochlear Implants: Audiological Foundations, and several others on tinnitus, including Tinnitus Handbook, Tinnitus Treatments, and A Consumer Handbook of Tinnitus. He consults patients, and hosts an annual Tinnitus and Hyperacusis Treatment Workshop. Additionally, Tyler served on committees such as The National Science Foundation, World Health Organization, Department of Defence, American Academy of Otolaryngology, and Veterans Administration.

**James Henry** PhD, is a licensed audiologist with a doctorate in Behavioural Neuroscience. He is a United States Veterans Affairs (VA) Rehabilitation Research & Development (RR&D) Senior Research Career Scientist at the VA RR&D National Center for Rehabilitative Auditory Research (NCRAR) located in Portland, Oregon, USA. He is also Research Professor, Department of Otolaryngology – Head & Neck Surgery, Oregon Health & Science University. His work for the past 30 years has focused on developing and validating clinical methodologies for management of tinnitus and increasing access to tinnitus services.
